### **COVID 19 Vaccination Awareness, Screening, and Testing Activation**

**31 March 2022: Ga-Rankuwa Complex, Tshwane, Gauteng**

On 31 March 2022, the GCIS Information Resource Centre team in partnership with the Gauteng GCIS Office, Department of Health and Tshwane Health, metro police, Doctors without borders, Sefako Makgato University, and other stakeholders held a COVID-19 Vaccination awareness campaign and wellness day at Ga Rankuwa complex, in Tshwane, Gauteng.
