This saw lives being lost by the South African community and also those of our brothers and sisters from other African countries. The Inter-Ministerial Committee on Migration which included Ministers: Jeff Hadebe, Bathabile Dlamini, Lindiwe Zulu, Michael Masutha, Deputy Ministers Manamela and Landers together with the KZN MEC for Social Development, Weziwe Thusi and eThekwini Municipality Deputy Mayor, Nomvuso Shabalala, paid their respect to those South African families that lost their loved ones during the attacks directed at Foreign Nationals.
