PICTORIAL REPORT OF INTER-MINISTERIAL VISIT TO ELECTION HOTSPOT- KWAMASHU F SECTION: 17 APRIL2014

The Justice, Crime Prevention and Security (JCPS) Cluster led by Minister of Police Mr Nathi Mthethwa visited KwaMashu F Section on 17 April 2014 to engage with the community about the importance of peaceful elections. This section of KwaMashu is a politically volatile area and the site of many politically motivated violent incidents. Accompanying Minister Mthethwa were Minister of Defence Nosiviwe Mapisa-Nqakula, Minister of State Security Dr Siyabonga Cwele, Police Commissioner General Riah Phiyega, Secretary of Defence Dr Samson Gulube and the Chairperson of the Independent Electoral Commission (IEC) Advocate Pansy Tlakula as well as the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Electoral Officer Mr Mawethu Mosery.
