purpose of National Communication Strategy Framework, and to sensitize provincial communicators to develop their communication strategies and communication policies in line with the approved NCSF.

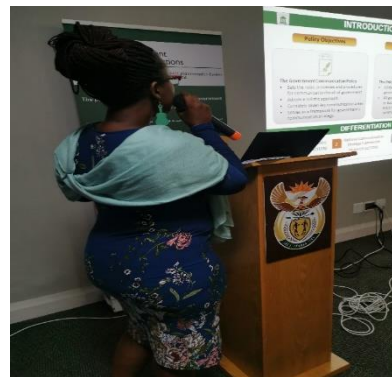
